This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Affiliation i.e Upgradation to Senior Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that:-
1 ✓	The total number of sections of the school shall be restricted to 29. Any further increase of section shall require prior approval of the Board, subject to compliance with affiliation bye laws and availability of rooms of 500 sq. ft. dimension.
2	The ramp to access upper floors appears to be overlaid on a staircase; hence it is very steep and unsafe, which is not acceptable. It is very difficult for wheelchair bound students/staff to navigate wheelchair/walker on ramp. Therefore, the school is directed to dismantle the same and re-construct the ramp as per the provision laid in RpWD Act and Board's guidelines and submit compliance. <i>vide</i>
3	The school has converted regular cubicles into CWSN toilets on ground floor which are very small and narrow and there is no room for a wheelchair/walker to navigate. The doors of the toilets at upper floor are too narrow to allow the entry of wheelchair inside the toilet. Thus, the school is required to take necessary action in r/o above and construct the separate CwSN toilets for boys and girls on every floor with proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPwD Act and Board's guidelines and submit compliance. <i>vide</i>
4 ✓	The school shall ensure the training of its teachers with CoE Bhubaneswar within 3 months and submit the compliance. <i>doc</i>
5 ✓	School is required to upgrade its facilities in the light of SOPs and guidelines issued by the Board, address to the above advisory points and remove the deficiencies mentioned above and submit videographic proof within 3 months on the SARAS portal.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye-Laws-2018. *fire, building safety, hand certificate, medical examination.*
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity/activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within in the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
