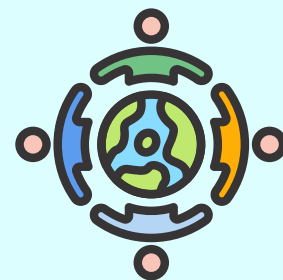
Investiture Ceremony

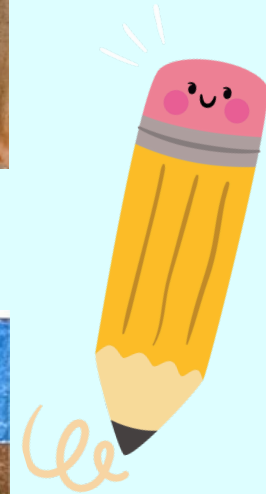

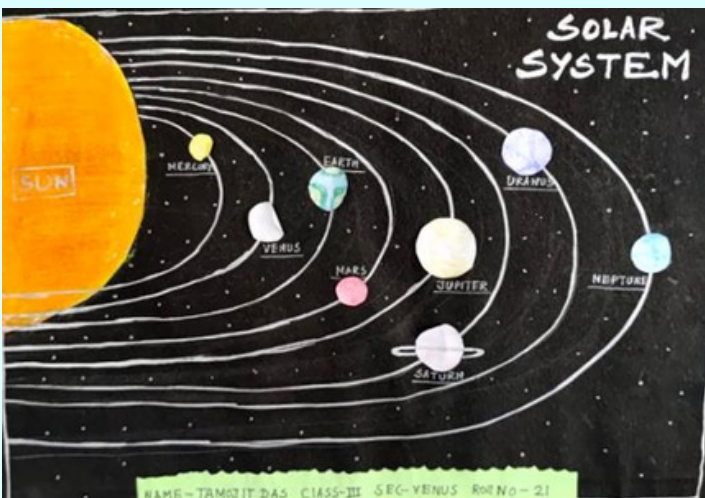

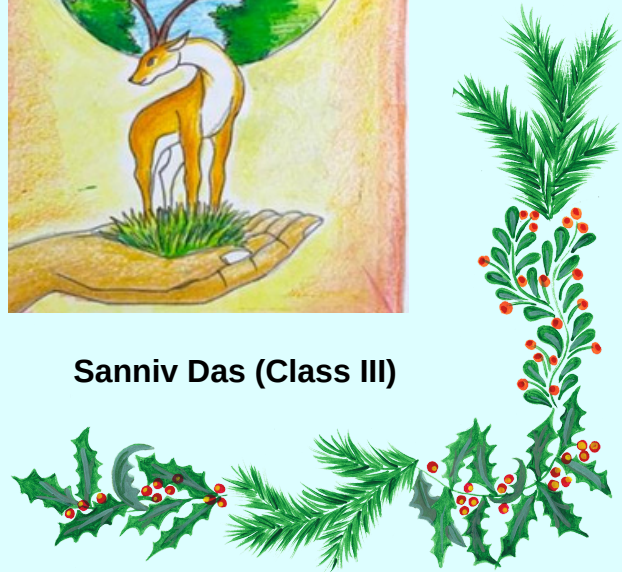
